1. While the undersigned greatly appreciates the initial extension provided for the Clerk's Record of Appeal in this case, the undersigned's Court Specialist in charge of this appeal is in need of another extension. The size of this case alone requires another extension to ensure that all filings and documents in the court record are completed correctly; however, her regular duties as the Circuit Criminal Court Specialist for Presiding Circuit Judge Hughes as well as handling all other criminal appeals currently pending in this circuit also support this request for additional time.
