UNITED STATES' MOTION TO CONDUCT A FORFEITURE HEARING

Comes now the United States of America, by and through Louis V. Franklin, Sr., United States Attorney for the Middle District of Alabama, and respectfully moves this Court to set a forfeiture hearing regarding the forfeiture allegation in this case.

1. On September 22, 2017, an Information containing a forfeiture allegation was filed against the Defendant. (Doc. #1).
2. On September 25, 2017, the Defendant pled guilty to Count 1 of the Information.
3. The United States requests, pursuant to Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 32.2(b)(1)(B), that this Court conduct a hearing to determine the amount of a forfeiture money judgment.
4. Specifically, the United States is requesting a \$50,657.46 forfeiture money judgment. That amount represents the fraudulent loss the United States believes the Defendant is responsible for.
5. Sentencing in this case is set for January 11, 2018.
6. The United States requests that the forfeiture hearing be held immediately prior to the sentencing hearing.
7. The United States intends to rely substantially on evidence that is already part of the record and estimates the hearing to take no more than ten minutes.

WHEREFORE, the United States respectfully requests that this motion be GRANTED.
