4. That the respondent's sole income consists of \$3415.00 per month of which \$2446.81 is obligated to the bank for direct payment on various loans. The respondent has a total of \$968.19 per month for living expenses. The respondent is trying to avoid taking a bankruptcy because it will effect so many others that depend on him.

Wherefore the Premises Considered, the Respondent would ask the Court to Modify the parties Divorce Decree to reflect the respondent's actual income and to consider that his future income will be considerably less because of his poor health.
